Introduction

For the project I am going to be gathering information to find out the answer to my project question "What is the role of the midwife in the mother's point of view?" I am interested in finding out the answer to this because while is was researching information on Midwives I got more interested to know if the role has changed in anyway or has it always been the same. I am also interested in becoming a Midwife when I leave school and have been since year 9. I would like to be a Midwife because I am love working with children but I thought it would be even better to bring the children into the world.

To help me answer this question I will send a questionnaire to mothers with children of all ages to see what mums think the role of the midwife is. Originally my questionnaire was different and aimed for Midwives to answer it but I had to change it for mums to answer it because it was difficult to get in contact with enough Midwives to back up my research, where as I can get in touch with a lot of mums with children of all ages so I changed it for them mums to help me. I have changed my question again. It was "Has the role of the Midwife changed over the AoI last 20 years?". I changed this because when I got my questionnaires back there people wasn't a lot of mums with children under the age of ten so I decided to change it CHANGES to What is the role of the midwife in the mother point of view?" this is because it will be easier to get information from mums about what they think instead of focusing on the age of their child.

The outcome of this project will be to decide whether or not the role of the midwife has changed over the past 20 years. My objectives for the project are:

- To find out the role of the Midwives from the mums and Midwives point of view.
- To compare the experiences of the mums depending on their children's age.
- To find out the main roles Midwives played before and after the pregnancy.

Research

I have done some secondary research where I searched the internet. I was looking for the role of a midwife. I looked at several different sites but I didn't use the information because the sites weren't reliable. This was because they weren't actually midwife sites or anything to do with them they were just site were A02 Reliable someone is asking a question. I finally found a reliable site to get my information from. I know this information is reliable because the site had been made for families and it also had a lot of information about midwives as well. Also the site I used my information from had contacts on it and had good feedback. So this Good Reliable would make me think that the information is reliable. The advantage of using the internet to find information is that it finds more in depth information. Also it will explain what you already know but in more detail. The advantage of using the internet to get information for my project is that I need to compare what the role appropriate of the midwife is and what they actually do and see if it has changed. The

disadvantage of using the internet is that you find non reliable sites so you have to read it carefully to make sure you use the right information.

The other way I am going to be finding out information is by asking people AO2 PRIMARY questions. I have created a questionnaire to ask several mums. I will be asking them questions on the role their midwife carried out. I was trying to find out what mums think about the role of their midwives. By asking these types of questions | Ao2 will be able to get the different views and opinions from mums on what they APPLICATION thought about their midwives role. By asking open questions I was hoping to get a more detailed answer and also I would get opinions from all the mums. I also asked closed questions. This is because it would be easier to evaluate the answers. The audience I targeted was going to be five mums with children under the age of 10 and five mums with children over the age of 10. this was to get the different opinions from experienced mums and newish mums. But then I couldn't pick a targeted audience so I asked my teacher to send my questionnaire to other teachers. And advantage of this is that I have now got opinions from many mums. A disadvantage of doing a questionnaire is that some people didn't answer all the questions.



midwives are supposed to do or one of their roles, but nearly all the mums that filled out my questionnaire stated that this did not happen.
